Structure of Postgraduate Schemes of Study

All taught modules will have a credit weighting of 30 credits each, with 60 credits for dissertations. Candidates will be required to complete 180 credits for the award of MA and 120 credits for the award of Diploma.

Full-time MA candidates take four modules and a dissertation over 12 months. **Part-time MA candidates** take four modules and a dissertation over 24 months. There is some flexibility as to when modules are taken, but candidates will be advised to take account of the credit load between semesters where possible.

The same choices apply for **Diploma** candidates on these schemes, except that they do not undertake work for a dissertation.

Assessment

Academic work at the MA level requires detailed and considered study. All of our modules are examined by *assessment essays, assignments, or dissertation only*. The precise length of these pieces of work varies from module to module and figures are provided in the module outlines. Assessment is usually structured so that you work to a regular rhythm with work being handed in throughout the year. Deadlines follow the timetable below:

Assessed Essay Deadlines

Semester One Modules – 9th January 2012

Semester Two Modules – 21st May 2012

Dissertations – 3rd September 2012

Most modules allow for the production of 'formative ' written work, which provides for direct feedback to students on how to structure and improve assessed work.

Exams Results

Provisional marks and feedback will be provided on assessed work submitted throughout the year.

Final marks and awards will not be confirmed until the exam board meeting which is held annually in **October/November**.

Confirmed results will be available to students online in late November.

Degree ceremonies are held in **mid-December**.
